Minutes of Vestry Meeting held on Tuesday, July 17, 2018

- I. Opening Prayer
- II. Consent agenda
 - a. June Meeting Minutes: Joe Fennell moved; Lou Wynne seconded unanimous approval
 - b. Financial Report: Joe Fennell presented on behalf of Craig Church; Jan Puzar moved to accept; John Cobb seconded unanimous approval
- III. Staff Computer needs / phone status (Joe Fennell)
 - a. Joe Fennell ordered a new computer for Denise for \$778.93
 - b. Phone system issue is now being resolved through Northland
 - i. Awaiting determination if 5 old handsets can be used with new configuration
 - 1. If so, only a \$2.50/month increase for 5 new + 5 old on system
 - 2. If not, Northland will provide quote for 10 new handsets on system
- IV. Supply Priest Update (Jan Puzar)
 - a. Short term: all Sundays filled until Labor Day weekend; <u>Jan will ask Chuck</u> McDonnell to lead Morning Prayer on September 2
 - b. Long term: Both Tom Nicholl and Stephen Bolle would consider a long-term supply position with us
 - i. Proposed duties would require Sunday plus 2 days/1 night in Greenwood each week
 - 1. Pastoral care, other meetings, etc on Tuesday afternoons and the healing service on Wednesday mornings
 - 1x/month celebrate at Wesley Commons; 1x/month attend Vestry meeting
 - ii. <u>Vestry will decide offer at August meeting; Wardens request Vestry members attend the next 2 Sundays to review Tom's and Stephen's styles</u>
- V. Congregational Survey
 - a. A "snapshot" survey is taken on a typical Sunday morning

- b. Bishop requests survey every 3 years anyway but will help Search Committee in this case
- c. <u>Jan will request materials needed to take survey on September 9, right after</u> services
- d. Jan and/or Joe will find out if youth can be surveyed as well as adults
- VI. Duties of the Search Committee
 - a. Create our Ministry Portfolio, an in-depth picture of our parish
 - b. Review candidates provided by bishop
 - c. Interview candidates
 - d. Attend a service at each finalist candidate's current church
- VII. Charge to Search Committee
 - a. Vestry is responsible for writing a Charge outlining the duties and tasks of Search Committee
 - b. Anne Wells will draft a Charge based on example from St. Michaels & All Angels
- VIII. Suggestions for Search Committee members
 - a. Joe Fennell moved to increase the number of Committee members from 7 to 9; John Harte seconded unanimous approval
 - b. Joe provided a list of 33 names nominated by vestry members
 - i. <u>Vestry members must send Joe and Jan their list of Top 12 nominees as soon as possible</u>
 - 1. Request to consider gender, age, primary service attended (8:30/10:30) when selecting

 - a. Joe, John Harte, and Anne will meet regarding nursery playground

teacher this year, and Elizabeth would like Resurrection to adopt Ms. Fowler's 1st Grade class and help her outfit her classroom.

i. Joe Fennell moved to allow Elizabeth to pursue this project; John Cobb seconded — unanimously approved

b. Back lot issues

- i. A large tree was recently struck by lightning and suffered a lot of damage. Joe proposed taking it down immediately; Anne and others requested waiting to see if the tree can be saved.
