We are a people rooted in worship, branching out into the world.

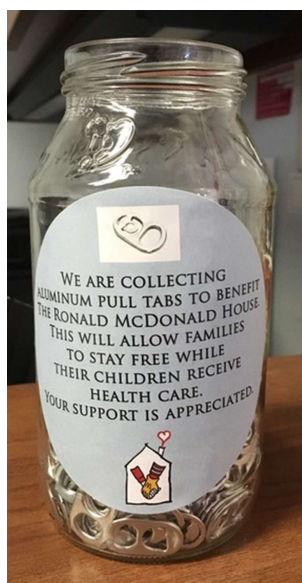
Dear Church of the Resurrection Family,

We will collect the tabs at the Church of the Resurrection and once a month send them to the Ronald McDonald House in Greenville. Ronald McDonald House takes the tabs to a local recycling center. Every year, more than \$10,000 is raised from this program.
