

# We've adopted schools!

Resurrection has adopted two elementary schools for the purpose of providing clothes: Mays Elementary and Rice Elementary. Guidance counselors often assist homeless and needy children without seasonally appropriate clothing, and these two schools in particular serve many such children. We donated clothes and shoes just before Christmas, and now we are asking the congregation to help us build up a clothes pantry for resupplying the schools as needed. This month's Second Sunday Give will support our clothes pantry, but you are encouraged to donate year-round as you wish. Clothes should be new or lightly used and should fit children ages 5 to 11. A temporary receptacle for donated items can be found in our parish nursery. If you have any

questions, please contact our coordinator, Sandra Lewis.




